PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Adult literacy needs and definitions

Our interest in reading, writing and counting ability among adults has started after studying principal strategy of „Europa 2020”, specially „European platform to eliminate poverty”, which proposes the educational development to people who are in very bad situation. This refers to people who experienced poverty, who are excluded from surrounding society and are not able to have a decent live in their community.

Another strong impulse, by Council Conclusion, is to improve the ability of reading which is very important skill. This ability is the essential key to express the development of individual reflection by forming verbal speeches and creating critical thinking, empathy and also stimulating personal growth. It increases self confidence and gives a feeling of identity with full involvement in society based on knowledge that is described as digitalization. Project is based on „Literacy”, the definition adopted by UE Council Conclusion from November 26, 2012:

„Literacy” – reading ability understood as a reading and writing competence that allows to understand and critical evaluate the use of different forms of information. It includes a hand writing text, printed or electronic version. It covers basic, functional and multilevel reading ability

Basic reading ability: knowledge of letters, words, text structure necessary for reading and writing on the level that gives a self confidence with motivation to further development.

Functional reading ability: the ability of writing and reading on the level that enables the progress and functioning in society, at home, school or at work

Multilevel reading ability: the ability to implement the reading and writing skills to create, understand and evaluate information in writing. It will utilize the active base in digital world with making conscious decisions in the field of finance, health and etc.

Aims and objectives

Main goal of this project is the exchange of experience and conducting trial training which will be the base to create learning tools. Those tools will be used for teaching essential skills (reading and writing) for adult students.
