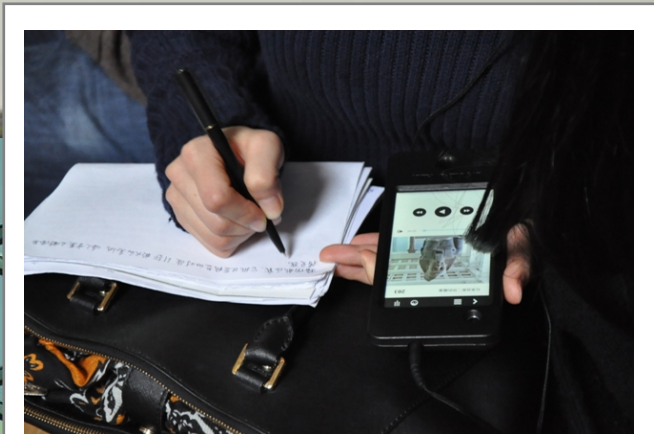
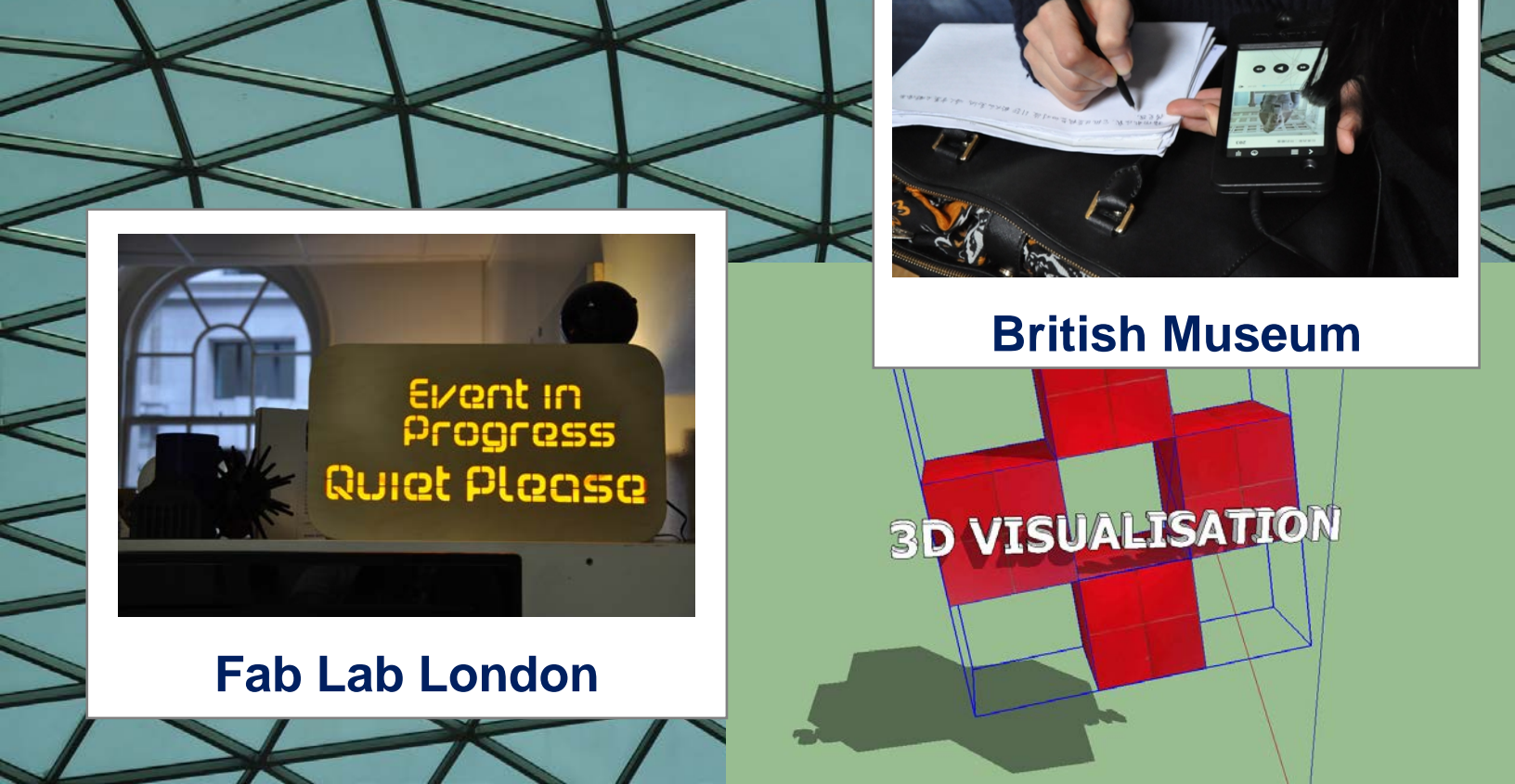

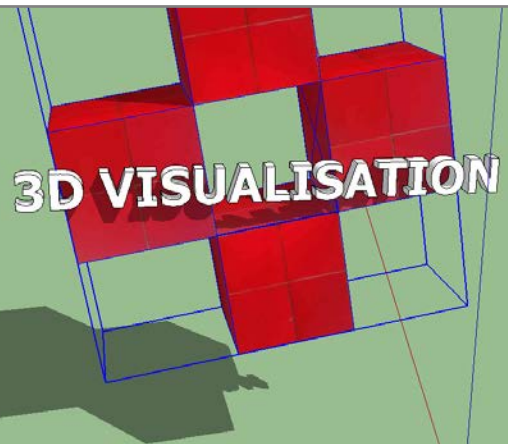

3D Visualisation for Learning in the Classroom with Mobile Phone Devices is an Erasmus+ project coordinated by Skills International GmbH from Austria.

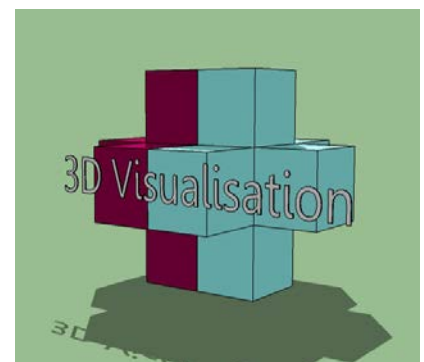
The aim of the project is to bridge the gap between the provision of traditional computer-based training offer with the requirements when using mobile devices.



We had the chance to film an English language course taught by JPE in London for female migrants, where one of the young learners explained to her colleagues how she uses her smart phone for learning.

A six days staff training took place in January 2016 at Joanna Pinewood Education Ltd in London. The method of the training is based on a joyful hands-on collaborative learning approach.

The two project partners Skills International (Austria) and Joanna Pinewood Education (UK) trialed to enhance skills and qualification to adapt existing learning solutions for mobile device applications and Open Educational Resources (OER).



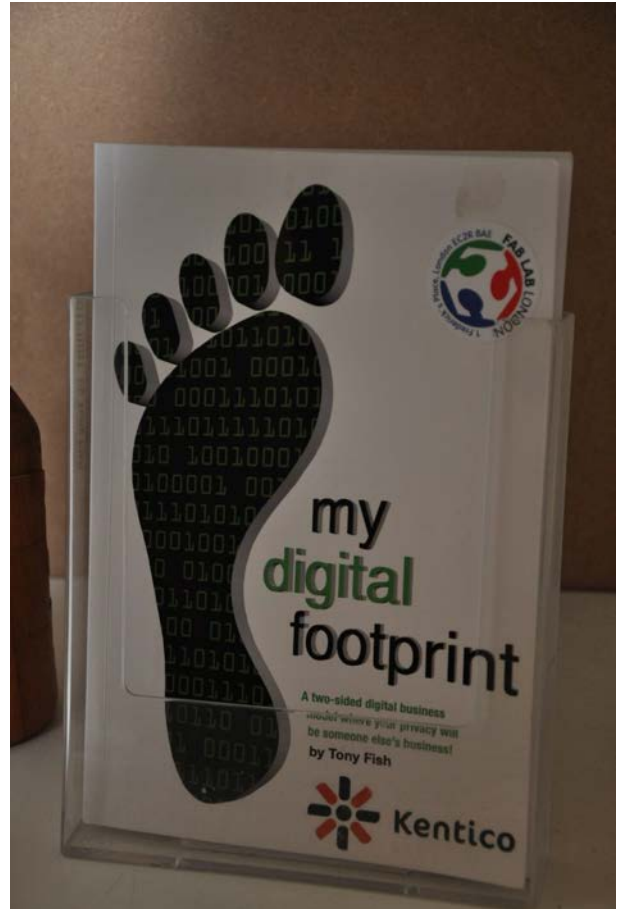

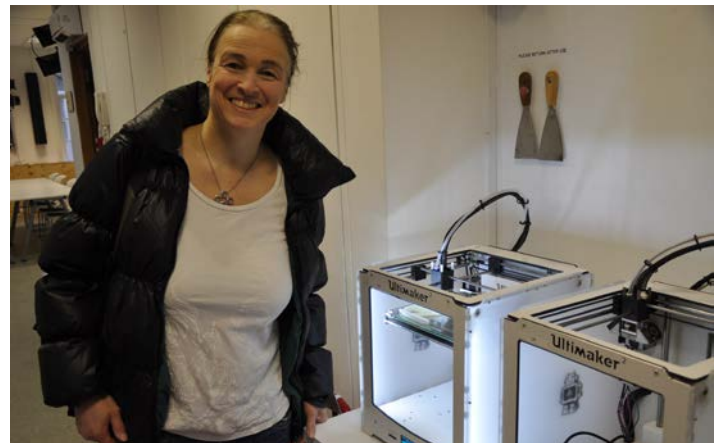
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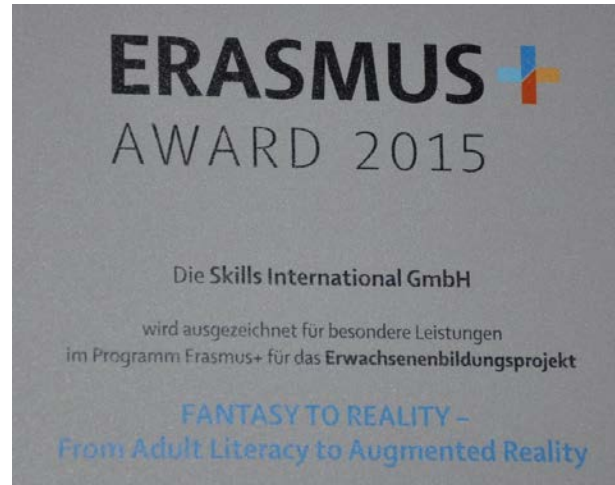
